4. Update and discussion on returning to the pool

CH gave an update on what pool time we will have available during August. At City we will have 3 hours each morning Monday to Friday at 8am to 11am plus two evenings Tuesday and Wednesday for two hours, along with the NK Thursday session at 6-9pm

Yarborough is due to open 10<sup>th</sup> August but not yet known what time will be offered as they are currently putting their programme together. All other pools we use will be September at the earliest to re-open.

With the coaches we will now look at giving all squads what we can during the time available and involving all squads. The squads will be split into bubbles that the swimmers will remain in for the time being.

This will all be undertaken following the Swim England guidance and risk assessment we have in place.

With the time that we have available it was agreed that Adam would remain on furlough for August and Paul would be brought back for 60% of his contracted hours.

Once the sessions etc are in place we will then look at costs per group and this will be emailed over the weekend for committee discussion and approval.
