I've included a summary of the key competitions below:

Counties – Great performances from the swimmers who attended, both from a swimming point of view and their professionalism. 89 medals from 17 different swimmers + Zara D, Alice D, Katie M,Holly M, Alex B & Alex M winning titles

Regionals

32 qualifiers, with Alice-Mae D, Holly M, Alex B, Jacob H and Mia C all winning medals.

Nationals
